

Course Description

WEB DESIGN

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This one-semester course introduces students to the mechanics and elements of web design. Students will learn the key elements of design and HTML, the concepts of planning and organizing websites, and documentation and copyright issues associated with website design. Students will progress through the course, engaging in a variety of project-based assessments to evaluate their understanding.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: After completing the course, students will be able to:

1. Have a better understanding of planning and organizing a website
2. Understand elements of design and HTML
3. Explain copyright and fair use doctrines and how they apply to website creation
4. Use WYSIWIG editor and other online tools to create a website
